

**COLORADO RIVER FAIR
AMBASSADOR'S SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

In applying for this Scholarship, you should know all of the following important factors. These will all apply to you should you be awarded this Scholarship and they may be part of you interview questions. A Fair Ambassador is a representative of the Fair during the pre-fair and Fair Season. The amount of funds available for this scholarship, per each of five Ambassadors chosen, will range from \$400 to \$800 dollars.

- A. Scholarship funds must be used within two years of graduation from High School. In special circumstances this may be extended by Fair Management.*
- B. We must receive a copy of your registration before payment can be made. 1/2 of your scholarship is awarded the first semester and 1/2 the second semester. (You must provide a copy of your registration for the second semester to receive the second payment.)*
- C. You must remain a full time student. (12 units minimum) to receive your scholarship.*
- D. All correspondence relating to your scholarship must be sent to the Fairgrounds office.*
- E. You must participate in all scheduled Ambassador activities which may include, but are not limited to: Helping to construct and riding in a float for the 2016 Christmas Parade; Devising a game show or other presentation which provides information about the fair, and presenting it to local community clubs; Assisting with clerking for the Poultry, Rabbit, Horse and Livestock Shows; Judging the Barn Duty award at Fair .*
- F. You must conduct yourself as an Ambassador from the time of award through Fair 207. You may not use Alcohol or Drugs. You may not smoke at anytime in any place while fulfilling your duties. You must keep in mind at all times that you are a role model. Expulsion from or Suspension from school may terminate your Scholarship.*

UP TO 1 of the Ambassadors MAY be chosen from the community High School students who are not members of the 4-H or FFA.
